You will also see a final section that allows you to directly compare the difference in cost between spending a term at the University of Florida and spending that *same* term abroad.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Expenses strictly related to study abroad, that you would not incur at the University of Florida, have been highlighted in red.
- Blocks shaded in gray do not need to be filled in with any numerical/cost values.
- Some "Additional Expenses" are one-time expenses, while others are recurring. For those that would
 be recurring, it is recommended that you estimate the total amount you would spend during your entire
 time abroad.
